

Fishing in Wandsworth

Where, when and how

Where?

- Battersea Park lake fishing area
- Wandsworth Common lake - southern basin
- Tooting Common main lake

When?

The fishing season runs from 15 June to 15 March inclusive.

How to get a fishing permit

In order to fish in any of the above three waters you must have a Wandsworth Council Fishing Permit. If you are aged 12 or over, it's a national requirement that you also have an [Environment Agency Rod License](#). To get a fishing permit for our lakes please write to us at:

Please enclose:

- a photocopy of your current Environment Agency rod license (note that if you are old enough to be required to hold a rod license, we will not issue a council permit without proof of rod license)
- a cheque/ cash made payable to Enable Leisure and Culture for the correct amount
- Two passport sized photos chief

And, if applying for a concessionary price, please also include:

- proof of age for the junior or senior concessions, or
- proof of disability for the disability concession

Ages and prices

From June 2017 to March 2018 season, the prices are:

- adult £89.00 per season
- senior (age 65 and over) £65.00
- junior (age under 16) £47.50
- people with disabilities £47.50
