

## Wandsworth Common MAC – Member Profile

Residents wishing to stand for election to the MAC do not need any particular skills or expertise - a passion for the common, enthusiasm and commitment are the most important credentials.

### Requirements

1. You should be a regular user of Wandsworth Common.
2. Be either a local resident or a representative of a local society, club or organisation that uses the Common.
3. Be committed to delivering the MAC's vision for Wandsworth Common, as "*a free and open natural green space for everyone to protect and enjoy*".
4. Be prepared to attend five Committee meetings and one Annual Public Meeting each year.
5. Be willing to get involved in activities between Committee meetings such as Working Groups, Wandsworth Council meetings and meetings with Contractors etc. (These are likely to be associated with the particular interests of individual MAC members e.g. sport, children's amenities, ecology, governance and/or management etc.)
6. Be open-minded, respectful of others and committed to the management of the Common for the benefit of all users.
7. Work in the interest of the MAC as a whole, rather than their own or those of a narrow interest group.

### Supplementary Expertise

Whilst there is no requirement for any particular skills or experience, the following areas of expertise or knowledge are helpful to the work of the MAC: governance, contract management, business planning, ecology, arboriculture, public policy, planning, sports and recreation management, legal, event planning, marketing and PR.
