

Visiting Putney Vale Cemetery and the gardens of remembrance

Access to the grounds

Putney Vale is open to the public at our normal advertised times.

The following limitations are in place until further notice.

- The Putney Vale pedestrian gates at East and West lodges have reopened
- Visitors must maintain a social distance of at least 2 meters from other visitors and staff
- Sporting activities are not permitted in cemeteries by law
- Picnics or the consumption of alcohol (or the use of drugs) is not permitted
- No more than six persons (from the same family bubble) are permitted in a group
- Do not arrange to or meet with groups of friends or family in the grounds. Please note that the Police may be called to disperse large gatherings

Planning your visit.

- You must not visit if you are unwell, vulnerable or self-isolating
- The car park at Putney Vale is closed and temporary parking is provided along the drive. No vehicles other than the hearse and limousines are permitted around the crematorium building. Please follow temporary signage
- Please do not approach staff, grave diggers or grounds people. Please let them carry out their work in safety. Please contact the office with any enquiries

Normal cemetery regulations continue to apply and must be adhered to and the above re-opening and restrictions will be monitored and reviewed over the coming weeks.

As you are aware, we are in unprecedented times, and therefore have had to make necessary changes to our facilities to ensure that we follow Government guidance on limiting the spread of Coronavirus.

We are taking the necessary steps to keep our communities safe.
